

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note does not form part of the Scheme, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

This Scheme provides a means for comparative testing of the stock of Accredited Poultry Farms and other poultry breeders. Part I is divided into two tests. Section I test (a) is a cockerel test in which the pure bred daughters of the cockerels are tested in order to ascertain the merits of the sire. Section I test (b) is a test of pure bred pullets hatched from a random sample of eggs laid by the entrant's stock of that breed. Section II is concerned with the testing of commercial stock hatched from a random sample of eggs laid by the entrant's pure or repeatable cross bred birds.

This testing will be carried out at the Poultry Testing Station at Gosford, Markethill.

## EDUCATION

## Educational Services Grants

REGULATIONS, DATED 9TH JANUARY, 1962, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER SECTIONS 104 AND 112 OF THE EDUCATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1947, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 104 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Educational Services (General) Grants Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1962.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the date hereof.

2. In accordance with arrangements approved by the Ministry of Finance, and subject to the requirements of these Regulations, the Ministry may make grants to such bodies (hereinafter referred to as "the recipients") as the Ministry may determine in respect of expenditure incurred by the recipients on educational services provided for Northern Ireland.

3. The recipients shall furnish to the Ministry each year such statement of accounts duly certified by a qualified accountant and such other information relating to the recipient's work in Northern Ireland as the Ministry may from time to time require.

4. The total of the grants made by the Ministry under these Regulations shall be such amount as the Ministry, with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, may determine.
