### MENTAL HEALTH

#### Special Care Services Travelling Expenses

REGULATIONS, DATED 28TH MARCH, 1962, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER THE MENTAL HEALTH ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1961.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 112 and Article 15 of the First Schedule to the Mental Health Act (Northern Ireland), 1961(a), and in conjunction with the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Special Care Services (Travelling Expenses) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1962, and shall come into operation on 2nd April, 1962.

2.—(1) The Northern Ireland Hospitals Authority (in these Regulations referred to as “the Authority”) may subject to the same rules and conditions make to members of any Special Care Management Committee the like payments as may be made by the Authority to members of a Hospital-Management Committee under the Health Services (Travelling Expenses) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1953(b):

(2) Any reference in these Regulations to a Special Care Management Committee shall be deemed to include a reference to a sub-committee of that committee.
