RESIDENT MAGISTRATES: SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES

ORDER, DATED 5TH APRIL, 1962, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS WITH THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MINISTER OF FINANCE, UNDER SUB-SECTION (4) OF SECTION SIX OF THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1935.

I, the Right Honourable Brian Faulkner, Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sub-section (4) of section six of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland), 1935(a), do hereby make the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Resident Magistrates (Salaries and Allowances) Order (Northern Ireland), 1962, and shall have effect as from the 5th April, 1962.

Revocation

2. The Resident Magistrates (Salaries and Allowances) Order (Northern Ireland), 1960(b), is hereby revoked.

Salaries of Resident Magistrates

3.—(1) The annual salary payable to a Resident Magistrate appointed for the City of Belfast shall be three thousand four hundred and twenty-five pounds, which salary shall, where appropriate, be deemed to include the annual salary of two hundred pounds to which a Resident Magistrate is entitled by virtue of the Resident Magistrates (Belfast) Act, 1911(c).

(2) The annual salary payable to every other Resident Magistrate shall be three thousand one hundred and seventy-five pounds.

Allowances of Resident Magistrates

4. In addition to the salary specified in Article 3 a Resident Magistrate shall be paid an allowance in respect of travelling, subsistence and incidental expenses at such rate and subject to such conditions as may from time to time be fixed by the Ministry of Home Affairs, with the concurrence of the Ministry of Finance.

Salaries and Allowances of temporary Resident Magistrates

5. The salary to be paid to a temporary Resident Magistrate shall be at the rate of twelve pounds for each day upon which he adjudicates, together with travelling and subsistence allowances as may from time to time be fixed by the Ministry of Home Affairs, with the concurrence of the Ministry of Finance.
