ELECTORAL LAW ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1962**Date of Commencement**

ORDER, DATED 1ST MAY, 1962, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SUB-SECTION (2) OF SECTION ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-TWO OF THE ELECTORAL LAW ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1962(a).

I, The Right Honourable Brian Faulkner, Minister of Home Affairs, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by sub-section (2) of Section One Hundred and Thirty-two of the Electoral Law Act (Northern Ireland), 1962 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Electoral Law Act (Northern Ireland), 1962 (Commencement No. 1) Order (Northern Ireland), 1962.

2. The provisions of the Act other than the provisions specified in the first column of the Schedule (which relate to matters specified in the second column of the said Schedule) shall come into operation on the 1st day of May, 1962.
