

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

These Regulations make a Scheme varying the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation (Supplementation) Scheme (contained in the Schedule to the Workmen's Compensation (Supplementation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1951) in consequence of the Workmen's Compensation (Supplementation) Act (Northern Ireland) 1963, to improve the allowances payable out of the Industrial Injuries Fund in respect of injury or disease arising out of employment before 5th July 1948, when the National Insurance (Industrial Injuries) Act (Northern Ireland) 1946 came into force.

The Scheme does not apply to persons entitled to the allowances for total incapacity or disablement provided by the Workmen's Compensation (Supplementation) Act (Northern Ireland) 1956, the rates of these having been increased by the 1963 Act.

## COUNTY COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1959

## Date of Commencement

ORDER, DATED 23RD MAY, 1963, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 154(2) OF THE COUNTY COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1959.

I, the Right Honourable William Craig, Minister of Home Affairs, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 154(2) of the County Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1959(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") do hereby order as follows:—

*Citation*

1. This Order may be cited as the County Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1959 Date of Commencement Order (Northern Ireland) 1963.

*Appointed day for certain provisions of the Act*

2. The provisions of the Act specified in the first column of the Schedule (which relate to matters specified in the second column of the Schedule) shall come into operation on the 1st June, 1963.
