DISEASES OF ANIMALS**Transit of Animals by Road**

ORDER, DATED 25TH JULY, 1963, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER THE DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1958(a).

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 13 and 53 of the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland) 1958, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order which may be cited as the Transit of Animals by Road (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1963, shall come into operation on 25th July, 1963, and shall be read as one with the Transit of Animals by Road Order (Northern Ireland) 1962(b) (hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order").

Amendment of the Principal Order

2. After Article 4(4) of the Principal Order there shall be inserted the following paragraphs:—

"(5) A Local Authority may—

(a) carry out the cleansing and disinfection in the manner required by this Order on behalf of the owner or the person using or the person in charge of any vehicle or thing, and may make a charge reasonably sufficient to cover the cost of so doing; or

(b) provide or cause to be provided facilities for the carrying out of such cleansing and disinfection, and make or authorise to be made charges for the use of such facilities reasonably sufficient to cover the cost of the provision and maintenance thereof. Where the Local Authority causes such facilities to be provided, the person providing them shall make only such charges as may be approved by the Local Authority.

(6) Where any vehicle or thing required by this Order to be cleansed and disinfected is at a market, fairground or saleyard at which a Local Authority is ready and willing to carry out the cleansing and disinfection or at which the Local Authority provides or causes to be provided such facilities as aforesaid, it shall be cleansed and disinfected before it is removed from such market, fairground or saleyard, except in any case to which the proviso to paragraph (1) of Article 4 applies."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Transit of Animals by Road Order (Northern Ireland) 1962 requires, amongst other things, that all vehicles, and their equipment, used for the movement of animals by road shall be cleansed and disinfected after each occasion on which they are used. Under this amending Order a Local Authority may provide or cause to be provided facilities for such cleansing and disinfection and make a reasonable charge for this service.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT

Compulsory Acquisition of Land

REGULATIONS, DATED 30TH JULY, 1963, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1934.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1934(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Local Government (Compulsory Acquisition of Land) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1963, and shall come into operation on 1st October, 1963.

2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:—

(a) "the Act" means the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1934;

(b) "the Ministry" means the Ministry of Health and Local Government.

3. An application for a vesting order in pursuance of the provisions of section 22 of the Act shall be in the Form No. 1 in the Schedule and shall be accompanied by a map or plan in duplicate drawn on parchment or linen, together with a copy of the map or plan on paper, indicating clearly the lands, easements or rights proposed to be acquired.

4.—(1) Notice of the application in the Form No. 2 in the Schedule shall be published once at least in each of two successive weeks in one or more of the newspapers circulating in the locality in which the lands, easements or rights proposed to be acquired are situate:

Provided that where a substantial number of interests are involved the schedule to Form No. 2 may be varied so as to include a general description only of the lands, easements or rights.
