

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Transit of Animals by Road Order (Northern Ireland) 1962 requires, amongst other things, that all vehicles, and their equipment, used for the movement of animals by road shall be cleansed and disinfected after each occasion on which they are used. Under this amending Order a Local Authority may provide or cause to be provided facilities for such cleansing and disinfection and make a reasonable charge for this service.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT

Compulsory Acquisition of Land

REGULATIONS, DATED 30TH JULY, 1963, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1934.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1934(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Local Government (Compulsory Acquisition of Land) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1963, and shall come into operation on 1st October, 1963.

2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:—

(a) "the Act" means the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1934;

(b) "the Ministry" means the Ministry of Health and Local Government.

3. An application for a vesting order in pursuance of the provisions of section 22 of the Act shall be in the Form No. 1 in the Schedule and shall be accompanied by a map or plan in duplicate drawn on parchment or linen, together with a copy of the map or plan on paper, indicating clearly the lands, easements or rights proposed to be acquired.

4.—(1) Notice of the application in the Form No. 2 in the Schedule shall be published once at least in each of two successive weeks in one or more of the newspapers circulating in the locality in which the lands, easements or rights proposed to be acquired are situate:

Provided that where a substantial number of interests are involved the schedule to Form No. 2 may be varied so as to include a general description only of the lands, easements or rights.

(2) Notice of the application in the Form No. 3 in the Schedule shall be given to the persons appearing to the local authority to have interests in the said lands, easements or rights:

Provided that—

- (i) where a substantial number of interests are involved the schedule to Form No. 3 may be varied so as to include a general description only of the lands, easements or rights; and
- (ii) if any of the persons to whom notice is required to be given should be absent from or resides outside the United Kingdom, or cannot be found, the notice may be left with the occupier of the lands or affixed on some conspicuous part of the lands proposed to be acquired.

5. A Statutory Declaration as to publication and service of notices shall be made by the Town Clerk or Clerk or Secretary or Solicitor of the local authority in the Form No. 4 in the Schedule and sent to the Ministry.

6. Notice of the making of a vesting order which is required to be given in pursuance of the provisions of section 22(2)(a) of the Act shall be in the Form No. 5 in the Schedule:

Provided that where a substantial number of interests are involved the schedule to Form No. 5 may be varied so as to include a general description only of the lands, easements or rights.

7. Notice of a vesting order becoming operative which may be given under section 22(2)(d) of the Act shall be in the Form No. 6 in the Schedule.

8. Notice of a vesting order becoming operative shall be given to the Ministry and to the Ministry of Finance within fourteen days from the date of such order becoming operative.

9. The receipt to be given to the local authority for the compensation paid by them shall be in the Form No. 7 in the Schedule.

10. The statutory declaration to be made by a person to whom the compensation payable does not exceed the sum of £100 shall be in the Form No. 8 in the Schedule.

11. The notice to be given to the Ministry of Finance in pursuance of the provisions of Article 10(2) of the Second Schedule to the Act shall be in the Form No. 9 in the Schedule. For the purposes of that Article the prescribed period shall be fourteen days from the receipt of such notice.

12. The Local Authorities (Compulsory Acquisition of Land) Regulations 1935(a), the Local Authorities (Compulsory Acquisition of Land) Regulations 1938(b) and the Local Government (Compulsory Acquisition of Land) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1962(c) are hereby revoked.

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations revise and consolidate the various regulations dealing with compulsory acquisition of land by local authorities made under Section 22 of the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1934.

EDUCATION

Teachers' Salaries

REGULATIONS, DATED 30TH JULY, 1963, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1947 TO 1962.

The Ministry of Education, in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 83 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland) 1947(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Teachers' Salaries Amending Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1963 No. 2.

(2) These Regulations other than Regulation 4 shall come into operation on 1st August, 1963. Regulation 4 shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st April, 1963.

2. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1961(b).

3. For Regulation 15 of the existing Regulations shall be substituted:—

“15.—(1) Subject to the provisions of these Regulations there may be paid in a school allowances (hereinafter referred to as “graded allowances”) in respect of such number of posts and of such maximum aggregate value as are indicated in Schedule VI or Schedule VII (as the case may be) as appropriate to the points score of the school and the type of school.

The teachers to whom such allowances may be paid shall, without prejudice to the power of the employing authority to pay such allowances to other teachers in special circumstances, include heads of departments and teachers undertaking special responsibility or special work of an advanced character.
