SUMMARY JURISDICTION

Petty Sessions Districts and Times

ORDER, DATED 7TH AUGUST, 1963, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 10(1) OF THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1935.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 10(1) of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland) 1935(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, after consultation with the County Court Judges and Resident Magistrates concerned, hereby orders and directs as follows:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Petty Sessions Districts and Times (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1963 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of October, 1963.

Abolition of Petty Sessions Districts of Clonmacate, Markethill, Moira and Gilford

2.—(1) The Petty Sessions District of Clonmacate shall be transferred to and become part of the Petty Sessions District of Portadown, and, in consequence of such transfer, the said Petty Sessions District of Clonmacate is hereby abolished.

(2) The Petty Sessions District of Markethill shall be transferred to and become part of the Petty Sessions District of Armagh, and, in consequence of such transfer, the said Petty Sessions District of Markethill is hereby abolished.

(3) The Petty Sessions District of Moira shall be transferred to and become part of the Petty Sessions District of Lurgan, and, in consequence of such transfer, the said Petty Sessions District of Moira is hereby abolished.

(4) The Petty Sessions District of Gilford shall be transferred to and become part of the Petty Sessions District of Banbridge, and, in consequence of such transfer, the said Petty Sessions District of Gilford is hereby abolished.

Times of holding certain Petty Sessions

3. Petty Sessions shall be held regularly in each month in the Districts set out in the first column of the Schedule at the times set out in the second column of the said Schedule and the Order made by the Ministry of Home Affairs on the 31st March, 1959(a), shall have effect accordingly.
