PUBLIC HEALTH**Water Supply****Armagh and Dungannon Waterworks Joint Board**

ORDER, DATED 12TH DECEMBER, 1963, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTION 7 OF THE WATER SUPPLIES AND SEWERAGE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1945.

Whereas the Urban District of Armagh and the Rural Districts of Armagh and Dungannon were by the Armagh and Dungannon Waterworks Joint Board Order (Northern Ireland) 1947(a) (in this Order referred to as "the Order of 1947") formed into a united district within the meaning of section 12 of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878(b):

And whereas it is expedient to amend the Order of 1947 for the purpose of enabling the Joint Board constituted by that Order to act as agent for any of the component authorities for the supply of water within the District of such authority:

Now, therefore, the Ministry, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 7 of the Water Supplies and Sewerage Act (Northern Ireland) 1945(c) hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Armagh and Dungannon Waterworks Joint Board (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1963, and shall be construed as one with the Order of 1947, and the two Orders may be cited together as the Armagh and Dungannon Waterworks Joint Board Orders (Northern Ireland) 1947 and 1963.

2. In Article 12 of the Order of 1947 the following paragraph shall be inserted between paragraph (2) and the proviso:—

"(3) It shall be lawful for the Joint Board and any of the component authorities to make and carry into effect, notwithstanding anything in any enactment to the contrary, any agreement whereby the Joint Board may act as agent for such authority for the supply of water within the area of the said authority."
