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**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

These regulations authorise the Ministry of Health and Local Government to pay grant at the rate of 50% towards the expenditure of health authorities in connection with Food Hygiene Advisory Committees set up under the Food Hygiene Advisory Committees Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1962.

**1963. No. 92****[C]****HOUSING****Housing Subsidy Order**

**ORDER\***, DATED 21ST FEBRUARY, 1963, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER SECTION 1 OF THE HOUSING (NO. 2) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1946.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government (in this Order referred to as "the Ministry") with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Ministry by Section 1 of the Housing (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland) 1946(a), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Housing Subsidy (Housing Associations) Order (Northern Ireland) 1963, and shall be construed as one with the Housing Subsidy Order (Northern Ireland) 1956(b) (in this Order referred to as "the principal Order").

2. In the application of the principal Order to a housing association after 31st December, 1962, the following paragraph shall be substituted for Article 9(2):—

\*This Order was confirmed by Resolutions of the Senate and of the House of Commons on the 30th day of April, 1963.

“(2) The Ministry shall, in pursuance of Section 1 of the Act of 1945 as applied to housing associations by virtue of Section 12 of the Act of 1946, pay to a housing association in respect of any housing accommodation provided by that association the like contributions as are payable to the Trust under paragraph (1).”

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

Hitherto housing associations received contributions which represented only the amount payable by the Ministry to a local authority; but in respect of houses for which a tender has been accepted by an association after 31st December, 1962, the contributions will be the same as those payable to the Northern Ireland Housing Trust, i.e., there will be an addition of the equivalent amount payable by a local authority to the credit of its Housing Revenue Account.

REGULATIONS, DATED 30TH APRIL 1963, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE UNDER THE FRIENDLY SOCIETIES ACT 1896.
