MAGISTRATES' COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1964**Date of Commencement**

ORDER, DATED 12TH AUGUST, 1964, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 173(2) OF THE MAGISTRATES' COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1964(a).

I, The Right Honourable Robert William Brian McConnell, Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 173(2) of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") do hereby order as follows:—

1. The provisions of the Act specified in the first column of the Schedule which relate to matters specified in the second column of the said Schedule shall come into operation on the 17th August, 1964.

2. This Order may be cited as the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964 (Date of Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1964.
