Petty Sessions Districts and Times

Order, dated 3rd September, 1964, made by the Ministry of Home Affairs under Section 10(1) of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland) 1935.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 10(1) of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland) 1935(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, after consultation with the County Court Judges and Resident Magistrates concerned, hereby orders and directs as follows:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Petty Sessions Districts and Times (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1964 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of October, 1964.
