"CALCULATION OF HOURLY RATES

Paragraph 3.

The general minimum time rates specified in paragraph 1 and in subparagraph (a) of paragraph 2 are weekly rates based on a week of 42 hours. For the purpose of calculating the hourly minimum rate the respective weekly rates should be divided by 42."

for paragraph 4 there were substituted the following paragraph—

"NORMAL WORKING DAY

Paragraph 4.

The normal working week shall consist of-

- (a) in the case of a worker who is normally \} 5 days of $7\frac{3}{4}$ hours each and required to work on 6 days of the week \} 1 day of $3\frac{1}{4}$ hours.
- (b) in the case of a worker who is normally \ 4 days of 8½ hours each and required to work on 5 days of the week \ 1 day of 8 hours.
- (c) in the case of a worker who is normally \ required to work on less than 5 days of the week

 $8\frac{1}{2}$ hours on each day."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order, which comes into operation on 15th September, 1964, amends the Road Haulage Wages Regulation Order (Northern Ireland) 1961 (Order N.I.R.H. (26)), as amended by the Road Haulage Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1963 (Order N.I.R.H. (30)), by increasing the statutory minimum remuneration fixed by those Orders.

Order N.I.R.H. (30) is revoked.

COUNTY COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1959

County Courts—County of Fermanagh

Order, dated 9th September, 1964, made by the Minister of Home AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 1 OF THE COUNTY COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1959.

I, the Right Honourable Robert William Brian McConnell, Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 1 of the County Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1959(a) do hereby order as follows:

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the County Court (Enniskillen Division) Order 1964 and shall come into operation on the 1st January, 1965.

Constitution of one division for County Fermanagh

2. For County Court purposes there shall be one division for the County of Fermanagh, which division shall consist of the baronies of Clankelly, Coole, Clanawley, Knockninny, Lurg, Magheraboy, Magherastephana and Tirkennedy and shall be called the "Enniskillen Division".

Place for holding court

3. The place at which the County Court for the aforesaid division shall be held shall be Enniskillen.

Revocation

4. The instruments specified in the first column of the Schedule are hereby revoked to the extent specified in the second column of the Schedule.
