Institutions of Further Education: Teachers' Salaries and Allowances

REGULATIONS, DATED 26TH NOVEMBER, 1964, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1947 TO 1963.

The Ministry of Education, in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 83 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland) 1947(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Institutions of Further Education (Salaries and Allowances) Amending Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1964, No. 2.

2. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Institutions of Further Education (Salaries and Allowances) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1963(b).

3. In paragraph (3)(c) of Schedule V to the existing Regulations for the words "To such extent as the service would be admitted by the appropriate local education authority in Great Britain" shall be substituted "To such extent as the Ministry may determine".

4. In paragraphs (3)(b), (d) and (e) of Schedule V to the existing Regulations the words "after such enquiry as it thinks fit" shall be deleted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

The purpose of these amendments is to give the Ministry the power to determine the extent of incremental credit in the case of service in schools in Great Britain and generally to rationalise the wording of similar provisions in the Schedule.
