## MARKETING OF EGGS

RULES, DATED 8TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1964, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 21 OF THE MARKETING OF EGGS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1957(a).

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 21 of the Marketing of Eggs Act (Northern Ireland) 1957 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Rules:—

*Short Title and Commencement*

1. These Rules may be cited as the Marketing of Eggs (Amendment No. 6) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1964 and shall come into operation on the 9th day of December, 1964.

*Amendment to the Marketing of Eggs Rules*

2. The Marketing of Eggs Rules (Northern Ireland) 1958(b) shall be amended as follows:—

In Rule 16 after paragraph (5) there shall be added the following paragraph:—

“(6) the interior of every vehicle used for the collection of eggs shall be kept clean. No live poultry or animals shall be conveyed in such a vehicle at the same time as eggs or egg cases or packing material and no such vehicle which has been used for the conveyance of live poultry or animals shall be used for transporting eggs or egg cases or packing material until that vehicle has been thoroughly cleaned and disinfected.”
