## **BETTING AND LOTTERIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1957**

ORDER, DATED 20TH MARCH, 1964, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 36 OF THE BETTING AND LOTTERIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1957.

I, The Right Honourable William Craig, Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 36 of the Betting and Lotteries Act (Northern Ireland) 1957(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, do hereby order as follows:

1. In Article 2 of the Betting and Lotteries Act (Northern Ireland) 1957 (Date of Commencement) Order 1959(b) (which relates to the coming into operation of Section 7(1)(j) of the Act) for the "1st day of April, 1964" there shall be substituted the "1st day of April, 1965".

2. This Order may be cited as the Betting and Lotteries Act (Northern Ireland) 1957 (Date of Commencement) (Amendment) Order 1964.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

# (This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order substitutes the 1st April, 1965, for the 1st April, 1964, for the coming into operation of Section 7(1)(j) of the Betting and Lotteries Act (Northern Ireland) 1957 (which provides that the minimum nett annual value of bookmakers' premises in Belfast should be £40, and elsewhere £30).
