

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

The discharge of certain noxious or offensive gases, smoke, grit and dust from certain types of works is subject to control under the Alkali &c. Works Regulation Act 1906, as extended by section 18 of the Clean Air Act (Northern Ireland) 1964. Both the type of works and the list of gases may be modified or added to from time to time by order of the Ministry of Health and Social Services under section 18(9) of the Clean Air Act (Northern Ireland) 1964, and this Order makes the modifications and additions specified therein.

**DESTRUCTIVE INSECTS AND PESTS****Importation and Planting of Potatoes**

ORDER, DATED 23RD JUNE, 1965, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER THE DESTRUCTIVE INSECTS AND PESTS ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1877 TO 1934.

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Destructive Insects and Pests Acts (Northern Ireland) 1877 to 1934(a), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Importation and Planting of Potatoes (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1965, and shall come into operation on the 15th day of July, 1965.

*Amendment of principal Order*

2. The Importation and Planting of Potatoes Order (Northern Ireland) 1964(b) is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) In Column 1 of the First Schedule between the words "Algeria" and "Belgium", there shall be added the word "Azores"; and in Column 2 of the said Schedule and opposite the word "Azores", there shall be added the words "Throughout the year".

(b) S.R. & O. (N.I.) 1964, No. 80.

(b) In Column 1 of the First Schedule between the words "Canary Islands" and "Cyprus" there shall be added the words "Channel Islands"; and in Column 2 of the said Schedule and opposite the words "Channel Islands", there shall be added the words "Throughout the year".

(c) In Columns 1 and 2 of the First Schedule, in place of the words

"France—excluding the Department of Finistère	1st March to 30th June inclusive."
---	------------------------------------

there shall be substituted the words

"France—Department of Corsica	Throughout the year.
—Other than the Departments of Corsica and Finistère	1st March to 30th June inclusive."

(d) In Columns 1 and 2 of the First Schedule, in place of the words

"Italy—Regions of Calabria and Sicily	Throughout the year.
---------------------------------------	----------------------

—Other than Calabria and Sicily	1st November to 20th May inclusive."
---------------------------------	--------------------------------------

there shall be substituted the words —

"Italy—Regions of Calabria, Sicily and Sardinia	Throughout the year.
—Other than Calabria, Sicily and Sardinia	1st November to 20th May inclusive."

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order amends the Importation and Planting of Potatoes Order (Northern Ireland) 1964 by permitting the importation of potatoes from the Azores and the Channel Islands, and by permitting the importation of new potatoes from Corsica and Sardinia throughout the year instead of during certain periods of the year.
