## Registration Expenses

REGULATIONS, DATED 30TH JUNE, 1965, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS WITH THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION 21(5) OF THE ELECTORAL LAW ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1962.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 21(5) of the Electoral Law Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(a) and of every other power it thereunto enabling and with the concurrence of the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Regulations:—

#### Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Electoral (Registration Expenses) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1965.

Scale of Registration Expenses

2. The scales of remuneration of officers and expenses set out in the Schedule will apply to the register of electors published under Section 28 of the Electoral Law Act (Northern Ireland) 1962 in the year 1965 and every year thereafter when there is published only registers of parliamentary electors.

5. Subject to paragraphs 7 and 8 the allowance for the expenses of an Electoral Officer in a County, including the remuneration authorised by paragraph 3 and the personal expenses authorised by paragraph 4(b), shall not exceed the sum of the following amounts:—

- (a) For so much of the Register as relates to Boroughs or Urban Districts, an amount calculated at the rate of 54/- per 100 electors.
- (b) For so much of the Register as relates to the rest of the County, an amount calculated at the rate of 69/- per 100 electors.
- 6. Subject to paragraphs 7 and 8 the allowance for the expenses of the Electoral Officer in the County Borough of Belfast shall not exceed an amount calculated at the rate of 38/- per 100 electors.
- 7. Where in a county or in the County Borough of Belfast there are more than 600 claims and objections in connection with the electors' lists the allowance specified in paragraph 5 or 6 as appropriate may be supplemented by an allowance not exceeding an amount calculated at the rate of £10 per 100 claims and objections in excess of 600.
- 8. An Electoral Officer shall be allowed as and for out-of-pocket expenses the actual and necessary cost of any:—

Stationery and miscellaneous local printing Postages
