## SUPERANNUATION

**Transfers from the Civil Service to the Teaching Service**

RULES, DATED 15TH OCTOBER, 1965, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION 12A OF THE TEACHERS (SUPERANNUATION) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1950.

The Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Finance acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Section 12A of the Teachers (Superannuation) Act (Northern Ireland) 1950(a) hereby make the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Superannuation (Transfers from the Civil Service to the Teaching Service) Amending Rules (Northern Ireland) 1965.

2. The existing rules hereby amended are the Superannuation (Transfers from the Civil Service to the Teaching Service) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1958(b).

3. Rule 3 of the existing rules shall be amended by the addition of the following paragraph:—

“(3) This Rule shall not apply to such a person as is referred to in paragraph (1) unless within three months after the date on which he has become employed in contributory service or within such longer period as the Ministry may in any particular case allow he notifies the Ministry in writing that he desires these Rules to apply to him.”

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the rules, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

The existing rules preserve the superannuation rights of a person who transfers from pensionable service under the Superannuation Acts relating to the Civil Service to pensionable service under the Teachers (Superannuation) Acts.

The amending rule provides that the rule shall not apply to a person who transfers from the Civil Service to Teaching Service unless he notifies the Ministry in writing within a reasonable time that he desires the rules to apply to him.
