EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order, which has been made with the approval of the Northern Ireland Trade Statistics Consultative Committee, prescribes that an undertaking employing not more than twenty-four persons shall be exempt from any requirement to furnish a return in respect of the census of production for the year 1965 and also exempts from the scope of the census all undertakings engaged in mining and quarrying.

METHYLATED ETHER

REGULATIONS, DATED 12TH NOVEMBER, 1965, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 9 OF THE INTOXICATING LIQUOR AND LICENSING ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1927.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 9 of the Intoxicating Liquor and Licensing Act (Northern Ireland) 1927(a) hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and Commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Methylated Ether (Amending) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1965 and shall come into operation on 1st December, 1965.

Sales for Manufacturing or Scientific Purposes

2. The Methylated Ether Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1959(b) shall be amended as follows:—

In Regulation 9 the words “to a wholesale dealer in ether and” shall be inserted after the word “grant”.
