**FACTORIES****Commencement No. 4 Order (Northern Ireland) 1965**

ORDER, DATED 19TH FEBRUARY, 1965, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER THE FACTORIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1959.

Whereas it is provided by section 35(2) of the Factories Act (Northern Ireland) 1959(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") that the provisions of the Act, other than sections 23 and 35, shall come into operation on such day or days as the Minister of Health and Social Services may by order appoint:

Now, therefore, I, the Right Honourable William James Morgan, Minister of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, in pursuance of the said section 35(2) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:—

1. Section 8(1) and (2) (Steam Boilers) of the Act shall come into operation on the 22nd day of March, 1965.

2. This Order may be cited as the Factories (Commencement No. 4) Order (Northern Ireland) 1965.
