MENTAL HEALTH

Payment of Fees

REGULATIONS, DATED 30TH APRIL, 1965, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER THE MENTAL HEALTH ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1961.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 90 and 112 of the Mental Health Act (Northern Ireland) 1961(a) and in conjunction with the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Mental Health (Payment of Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1965.

2. The Mental Health (Payment of Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1962(b) shall be amended as follows:—

(1) As from the 2nd April, 1962, until the 31st March, 1964, in Regulation 2 for the amount '£3. 3. 0.' where it occurs there shall be substituted the following:—

“(a) £4. 4. 0. for consultant or specialist work;

(b) £3. 13. 6. for medical work other than consultant or specialist work”.

(2) As from the 1st April, 1964, in Regulation 2 for the amount '£3. 3. 0.' where it occurs there shall be substituted the following:—

“(a) £4. 12. 6. for consultant or specialist work;

(b) £4. 0. 0. for medical work other than consultant or specialist work”.

These Regulations increase the fees to be paid to medical practitioners by hospital management committees for recommendations made under sections 12, 15 and 21 of the Mental Health Act (Northern Ireland) 1961.

AGRICULTURE

Cattle—Breeding Herds

SCHEME, DATED 30TH APRIL, 1965, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 1 OF THE AGRICULTURE (TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1954(a), AS AMENDED BY THE AGRICULTURE (TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE) (AMENDMENT) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1957(b).

The Minister of Agriculture, with the approval of the Minister of Finance and in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) Acts (Northern Ireland) 1954 and 1957, and of all other powers him thereunto enabling, hereby makes the following Scheme:—

Short title and commencement

1. This Scheme may be cited as the Cattle (Breeding Herds) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1965, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of May, 1965.

Definitions

2. In this Scheme—

“the Acts” means the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) Acts (Northern Ireland) 1954 and 1957;

“breeding cow” means a female bovine animal which has borne a calf;

“in-calf heifer” means a female bovine animal which was with calf for the first time on 1st January next preceding the qualifying day and which calves before the qualifying day;

“regular breeding herd” means a herd of breeding cows and in-calf heifers maintained throughout their normal breeding life in accordance with sound farming practice for the purpose of rearing calves suitable for beef production;

“the Ministry” means the Ministry of Agriculture;

“occupier” means a person who is in occupation of land under an estate or interest for a period of not less than twelve months and who is responsible for its management;

“premises” includes land which is occupied as a unit for agricultural purposes, together with any other land, including common land, used for any purpose in connection with such land;
