BELFAST COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL**City Architect's and City Surveyor's Staff Qualifications**

REGULATIONS, DATED 6TH JUNE, 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF DEVELOPMENT UNDER SECTION 18 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1934.

The Ministry of Development (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry"), in exercise of the powers vested in it by section 18 of the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1934(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Belfast County Borough Council (City Architect's and City Surveyor's Staff Qualifications) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966.

2. A person shall not be qualified to be appointed to any of the offices in the City Architect's or City Surveyor's Departments of the City and County Borough of Belfast as specified in the Schedule unless:

- (a) he possesses at least the qualifications set forth in the Schedule in relation to any particular post;
- (b) he has had adequate and suitable experience and has shown capacity in the practice of his profession; and
- (c) he is a British Subject.

3. The Belfast County Borough Council (City Architect's and City Surveyor's Staff Qualifications) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1961(b) are hereby revoked.

EDUCATION

Teachers' Salaries and Allowances

REGULATIONS, DATED 13TH JUNE, 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1947 TO 1963.

The Ministry of Education, hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry", in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 83 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland) 1947(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Teachers' Salaries Amending Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st August, 1966.

2. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1965(b).

3. That part of Schedule V to the existing Regulations referring to Special Schools shall be revoked and the following substituted therefor:
