HEALTH SERVICES

Medical Practices Compensation

REGULATIONS, DATED 23RD JUNE, 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER THE HEALTH SERVICES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1948.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 8 and 80 of the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland) 1948(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and in conjunction with the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following regulations:—

(a) 1948. c. 3.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Health Services (Medical Practices Compensation) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966, and shall come into operation on the 1st July, 1966.

2. The Health Services (Medical Practices Compensation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1950(a), as amended(b), shall be further amended as follows:—

At the end of regulation 12 (which deals with the time of payment of compensation) there shall be added the following paragraph:—

“(4) Compensation shall be payable to a practitioner (i) on the date specified in column 2 of the following table, if he has attained the age specified in column 1 before that date; or (ii) on attaining that age on or after that date:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

Under the existing regulations, compensation payable under Section 8 of the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland) 1948 in respect of the loss of right of a medical practitioner to sell the goodwill of his practice is payable on the retirement or death of the medical practitioner or in cases of hardship. These regulations provide that compensation shall also be payable when the practitioner attains a specific age, which will be reduced by one year annually from 70 in 1966 to 65 in 1971.
