Skimmed Milk with Non-Milk Fat

Labelling and Advertising

REGULATIONS, DATED 19TH JULY 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER SECTIONS 7 AND 68 OF THE FOOD AND DRUGS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1958.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Sections 7 and 68 of the Food and Drugs Act (Northern Ireland) 1958(a), having consulted with such organisations as appear to it to be representative of interests substantially affected by these regulations, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation and Commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Skimmed Milk with Non-Milk Fat (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966 and shall come into operation on 22nd July 1966.

Amendment of principal regulations

2. The Skimmed Milk with Non-Milk Fat Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1961(b) shall be amended by substituting for paragraph 5 of Part II of the Second Schedule the following paragraph:—

“5.—(1) S.M.A. in powder form shall contain—

- (a) not less than 11·6 per cent. of protein derived from milk;
- (b) not less than 27 per cent. of fat;
- (c) 92 ± 28 international units of vitamin D per ounce;
- (d) not less than 321 international units of vitamin A per ounce whether present as such or as its esters;
- (e) not less than 11·5 mg. of ascorbic acid per ounce.

(2) S.M.A. in liquid form shall contain—

- (a) not less than 2·6 per cent. of protein derived from milk;
- (b) not less than 6·2 per cent. of fat;
- (c) $22·5 \pm 7·0$ international units of vitamin D per fluid ounce;
- (d) not less than 140 international units of vitamin A per fluid ounce whether present as such or as its esters;
- (e) not less than 2·8 mg. of ascorbic acid per fluid ounce.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These amending regulations extend the Second Schedule to the Skimmed Milk with Non-Milk Fat Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1961 to exempt the food S.M.A. in liquid as well as in powder form from the requirement to bear on the label the declaration "Unfit for babies" (or the permitted alternatives).

HEALTH SERVICES

General Dental Services

REGULATIONS, DATED 20TH JULY 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER THE HEALTH SERVICES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1948.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 11 and 80 of the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland) 1948(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Health Services (General Dental Services Drugs) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966, and shall come into operation on 1st August 1966.

2. For schedule 3 to the Health Services (General Dental Services) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1964(b) (which schedule prescribes a list of drugs which a dentist may supply or order for a patient) there shall be substituted the following schedule:—

"SCHEDULE 3

List of prescribed drugs

Any reference to a drug includes a reference to any ingredient thereof and references to "B.P.", "B.P.C.", "B.N.F." and "D.P.F." are, except where otherwise stated, respectively references to the 1963 edition of the British Pharmacopoeia and the British Pharmaceutical Codex and the 1966 edition of the British National Formulary and the Dental Practitioners' Formulary.
