**FOOD AND DRUGS****Composition and Labelling****Cheese**

REGULATIONS, DATED 19TH JANUARY, 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER SECTIONS 4, 7 AND 68 OF THE FOOD AND DRUGS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1958.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Sections 4, 7 and 68 of the Food and Drugs Act (Northern Ireland) 1958(a), having consulted with such organisations as appear to it to be representative of interests substantially affected by these regulations, hereby makes the following regulations:—

**PART I****PRELIMINARY***Citation and commencement*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Cheese Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966 and shall come into operation on 1st February, 1967.

*Interpretation*

2.—(1) In these regulations—

“the Act” means the Food and Drugs Act (Northern Ireland) 1958;

“cheese” means the fresh or matured product intended for sale for human consumption, which is obtained as follows—

(a) in the case of any cheese other than whey cheese—

(i) by coagulating any or a combination of any of the following substances, namely milk, cream, skimmed milk, partly skimmed milk, concentrated skimmed milk, reconstituted dried milk and butter milk, and

(ii) partially draining the whey resulting from any such coagulation;

(b) in the case of whey cheese—

(i) by concentrating whey with or without the addition of milk and milk fat, and moulding such concentrated whey, or

(ii) by coagulating whey with or without the addition of milk and milk fat;

“cheese spread” means cheese which has been subjected to a process of melting and mixing with milk products other than cheese, with or without the addition of emulsifying salts;

“compound product” means food which has been prepared for sale uncooked and consists of a combination of two or more foods, and which does not contain less than 10 per cent. cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread or any mixture of two or more of them, as a percentage of the compound product;

- “container” includes any form of packaging of food for sale as a single item, whether by way of wholly or partly enclosing the food or by way of attaching the food to some other article, and in particular includes a wrapper or confining band;
- “emulsifying salts” means the sodium, potassium, calcium or ammonium salts of citric, phosphoric, polyphosphoric and tartaric acid;
- “hard cheese” means cheese other than soft cheese, whey cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread;
- “processed cheese” means cheese which has been subjected to a process of melting and mixing with or without the addition of emulsifying salts;
- “sell” includes offer or expose for sale or have in possession for sale, and “sale” and “sold” shall be construed accordingly;
- “sell by retail” means sell to a person buying otherwise than for the purpose of re-sale, but does not include selling to a caterer for the purposes of his catering business, or selling to a manufacturer for the purposes of his manufacturing business;
- “soft cheese” means cheese which is readily deformed by moderate pressure, but does not include whey cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread, and any reference to soft cheese includes a reference to cream cheese or curd cheese;
- “starter” means a living culture in milk, cream, skimmed milk, partly skimmed milk, concentrated skimmed milk, reconstituted dried milk, or butter milk, of lactic-acid-producing bacteria;
- “whey cheese” means the product obtained by one or other of the processes referred to in paragraph (b) of the foregoing definition of “cheese”.

(2) All percentages mentioned in these regulations are percentages calculated by weight and are calculated on the weight of the cheese as sold.

(3) Any reference in these regulations to a label borne on a container shall be construed as including a reference to any legible marking on the container however effected.

(4) For the purpose of these regulations, the supply of food, otherwise than by sale, at, in or from any place where food is supplied in the course of a business shall be deemed to be a sale of that food, and references to purchasing and purchasers shall be construed accordingly.

#### *Exemptions*

3. The following provisions shall not apply, except insofar as they relate to advertisements other than labels or wrappers, in relation to any cheese, processed cheese, cheese spread or compound product sold for—

- (a) exportation to any place outside the United Kingdom; or
- (b) consumption by a visiting force within the meaning of any of the provisions of Part I of the Visiting Forces Act 1952(a); or
- (c) use by a manufacturer for the purposes of his manufacturing business.

#### *Amendment of the Labelling of Food Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1961*

4. The Labelling of Food Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1961(b) shall be amended by inserting after the words “other than” in the first item in column 1 of Table C in Schedule 1 the words “cheese spread and”.

## PART II

COMPOSITION AND DESCRIPTION OF CHEESE, PROCESSED CHEESE  
AND CHEESE SPREAD*Composition and description of hard cheese*

5.—(1) Any hard cheese sold or consigned or delivered under the name of a variety specified in column 1 of Schedule 1, whether or not such cheese was manufactured in the United Kingdom, shall comply with the percentages for milk fat and water set out respectively in columns 2 and 3 of the said Schedule opposite the name of such cheese.

(2) Any hard cheese sold or consigned or delivered, other than hard cheese to which the foregoing paragraph applies, shall satisfy either the requirements of paragraph (a) or the requirements of paragraph (b) following, except that the appropriate description or declaration need be borne by any hard cheese sold or consigned or delivered otherwise than in a container only when such cheese is sold by retail,—

(a) such cheese shall bear one of the following descriptions and comply with the following compositional requirements for cheese of such description, namely—

- (i) “full fat hard cheese”, if the cheese contains not less than 48 per cent. milk fat in the dry matter, and not more than 48 per cent. water;
- (ii) “medium fat hard cheese”, if the cheese contains less than 48 per cent. and not less than 10 per cent. milk fat in the dry matter, and not more than 48 per cent. water;
- (iii) “skimmed milk hard cheese”, if the cheese contains less than 10 per cent. milk fat in the dry matter, and not more than 48 per cent. water; or

(b) such cheese shall bear a declaration of either—

- (i) the minimum percentage milk fat content in the dry matter, and the maximum percentage water content; or
- (ii) the minimum percentage milk fat content.

(3) No person shall sell or consign or deliver, as the case may be, any hard cheese in contravention of this regulation.

*Composition and description of soft cheese*

6.—(1) Any soft cheese sold or consigned or delivered, other than cream cheese which bears a description specified in paragraph (2) and complies with the corresponding compositional requirement, shall bear one of the following descriptions, and comply with the following compositional requirements for cheese of such description, except that the appropriate description need be borne by any soft cheese sold or consigned or delivered otherwise than in a container only when such cheese is sold by retail,—

(a) “full fat soft cheese”, if the cheese contains not less than 20 per cent. milk fat, and not more than 60 per cent. water;

(b) “medium fat soft cheese”, if the cheese contains less than 20 per cent. but not less than 10 per cent. milk fat, and not more than 70 per cent. water;

(c) “low fat soft cheese”, if the cheese contains less than 10 per cent. but not less than 2 per cent. milk fat, and not more than 80 per cent. water;

(d) "skimmed milk soft cheese", if the cheese contains less than 2 per cent. milk fat, and not more than 80 per cent. water.

(2) Any soft cheese sold or consigned or delivered as "cream cheese" shall contain not less than 45 per cent. milk fat, and bear the description "cream cheese":

Provided that if such cheese contains not less than 65 per cent. milk fat, it may bear the description "double cream cheese".

(3) No person shall sell or consign or deliver, as the case may be, any soft cheese in contravention of this regulation.

*Composition and description of whey cheese*

7.—(1) Any whey cheese sold or consigned or delivered shall bear one of the following descriptions and comply with the following compositional requirements for cheese of such description, except that the appropriate description need be borne by any whey cheese sold or consigned or delivered otherwise than in a container only when such cheese is sold by retail,—

- (a) "full fat whey cheese", if the cheese contains not less than 33 per cent. milk fat in the dry matter;
- (b) "whey cheese", if the cheese contains less than 33 per cent. and not less than 10 per cent. milk fat in the dry matter;
- (c) "skimmed whey cheese", if the cheese contains less than 10 per cent. milk fat in the dry matter.

(2) No person shall sell or consign or deliver, as the case may be, any whey cheese in contravention of this regulation.

*Composition and description of processed cheese*

8.—(1) Any processed cheese sold or consigned or delivered under a description containing the word "processed" with the name of a variety of cheese specified in column 1 of Schedule 1, whether or not such processed cheese was manufactured in the United Kingdom, shall comply with the percentages for milk fat and water set out respectively in columns 2 and 3 of the said Schedule opposite the name of such cheese:

Provided that processed Cheddar cheese shall contain not less than 48 per cent. milk fat in the dry matter, and not more than 43 per cent. water.

(2) Any processed cheese sold or consigned or delivered, other than any processed cheese to which the foregoing paragraph applies, shall satisfy either the requirements of paragraph (a) or the requirements of paragraph (b) following, except that the appropriate description or declaration need be borne by any processed cheese sold or consigned or delivered otherwise than in a container only when such processed cheese is sold by retail,—

- (a) such processed cheese shall bear one of the following descriptions, and comply with the following compositional requirements for processed cheese of such description, namely—
  - (i) "full fat processed cheese", if the processed cheese contains not less than 48 per cent. milk fat in the dry matter, and not more than 48 per cent. water;
  - (ii) "medium fat processed cheese", if the processed cheese contains less than 48 per cent. and not less than 10 per cent. milk fat in the dry matter, and not more than 48 per cent. water;
  - (iii) "skimmed milk processed cheese", if the processed cheese contains less than 10 per cent. milk fat in the dry matter, and not more than 48 per cent. water; or

- (b) such processed cheese shall bear a declaration of either—
- (i) the minimum percentage milk fat content in the dry matter and the maximum percentage water content; or
  - (ii) the minimum percentage milk fat content.

(3) Any processed cheese sold or consigned or delivered which is a mixture of cheese of two or more varieties shall conform to one of the compositional requirements of paragraph (2)(a) and bear the appropriate description specified therein for such processed cheese or bear one of the declarations specified in paragraph (2)(b).

(4) The name of a variety of cheese, used in the preparation of a processed cheese, not being a variety specified in column 1 of Schedule 1, may be inserted between the words "processed" and "cheese" in the appropriate description required by paragraphs (2)(a) and (3).

(5) No person shall sell or consign or deliver, as the case may be, any processed cheese in contravention of this regulation.

#### *Composition and description of cheese spread*

9.—(1) Any cheese spread sold or consigned or delivered shall contain not less than 20 per cent. milk fat and not more than 60 per cent. water; and shall bear the description "cheese spread" or "cheese food", with or without the name of the variety or description of cheese used as a constituent of such cheese spread inserted immediately before the words "cheese spread" or "cheese food", except that such description need be borne by cheese spread sold or consigned or delivered otherwise than in a container only when such cheese spread is sold by retail.

(2) No person shall sell or consign or deliver, as the case may be, any cheese spread in contravention of this regulation.

#### *Compound products*

10.—(1) Any cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread for which compositional requirements are specified and which is used as an ingredient of a compound product, shall comply with the compositional requirements so specified for such cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread.

(2) No person shall sell or consign or deliver, as the case may be, any compound product in contravention of this regulation.

#### *General requirements as to composition and description*

11.—(1) No person shall sell any food under such a description as to lead an intending purchaser to believe that he is purchasing any cheese, processed cheese, cheese spread or compound product respectively for which compositional requirements are specified if the food does not comply with the appropriate requirements as to composition set out in relation to that cheese, processed cheese, cheese spread or compound product.

(2) Where a person sells any food to a purchaser in response to a request for any kind of cheese, processed cheese, cheese spread or compound product for which compositional requirements are specified, he shall be deemed to sell cheese, processed cheese, cheese spread or a compound product of that kind and under such a description as is specified in relation to that kind of cheese, processed cheese, cheese spread or compound product unless he clearly notifies the purchaser at the time of sale that the cheese, processed cheese, cheese spread or compound product is not of that kind.

*Permitted ingredients in cheese, processed cheese and cheese spread*

12. No person shall sell or consign or deliver any cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread which contains any ingredient other than the substances mentioned in the definition of "cheese" in regulation 2(1), water, such preservatives in such amounts as are permitted by the Preservatives in Food Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1962(a), any mould characteristic of the variety of cheese concerned and any or all of the following ingredients where appropriate in relation to the kind of cheese specified, namely:—

- (a) Hard cheese may contain common salt (sodium chloride), calcium chloride, starter, rennet, carotene and annatto;
- (b) The rind of hard cheese may contain any colouring matter permitted by the Colouring Matter in Food Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1961(b);
- (c) Soft cheese and whey cheese may contain the ingredients mentioned in paragraph (a), alginic acid, calcium alginate, sodium alginate, carrageen, edible gums, edible starches (whether modified or not), flavourings and lecithin;
- (d) Processed cheese and cheese spread may contain—
  - (i) the ingredients mentioned or referred to in paragraph (c);
  - (ii) emulsifying salts;
  - (iii) any colouring matter permitted by paragraphs 1 and 2 in Part II of Schedule 1 to the Colouring Matter in Food Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1961; and
  - (iv) lactic acid and citric acid;
- (e) Hard sage cheese may contain—
  - (i) the ingredients mentioned in paragraph (a);
  - (ii) sage; and
  - (iii) any green colouring matter mentioned or referred to in paragraph 2 in Part II of Schedule 1 to the Colouring Matter in Food Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1961;
- (f) Soft sage cheese may contain—
  - (i) the ingredients mentioned or referred to in paragraph (c);
  - (ii) sage; and
  - (iii) any green colouring matter mentioned or referred to in paragraph 2 in Part II of Schedule 1 to the Colouring Matter in Food Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1961;
- (g) Sage cheese spread may contain the ingredients mentioned or referred to in paragraph (d), and sage.

## PART III

## LABELLING AND ADVERTISEMENT

*Labelling and advertisement of cheese, processed cheese, cheese spread and compound products*

13.—(1) No person shall sell or consign or deliver any cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread in a container unless such container bears a label on which there appears the appropriate description or declaration specified in regulation 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9 for such cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread:

(a) S.R. &amp; O. (N.I.) 1962, No. 173.

(b) S.R. &amp; O. (N.I.) 1961, No. 99.

Provided that in the case of hard cheese or processed cheese which complies with regulation 5(1) or 8(1), the label may bear instead of such description or declaration—

- (a) in the case of hard cheese, the name of the variety of such cheese, or
- (b) in the case of processed cheese, the word "processed" with the name of the variety of such processed cheese.

(2) No person shall sell by retail any cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread otherwise than in a container unless there appears on a ticket placed on or in immediate proximity to such cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread so as to be clearly visible to intending purchasers, the appropriate description or declaration specified in regulation 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9 for such cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread:

Provided that in the case of hard cheese or processed cheese which complies with regulation 5(1) or 8(1), the ticket may bear instead of such description or declaration—

- (a) in the case of hard cheese, the name of the variety of such cheese, or
- (b) in the case of processed cheese, the word "processed" with the name of the variety of such processed cheese.

(3) No person shall sell or consign or deliver any compound product in a container unless such container bears a label on which there appears as the description of such product the appropriate description or declaration specified in regulation 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9 for the cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread present in such compound product together with a true description of any other food, except an ingredient permitted by regulation 12, present in such compound product:

Provided that in the case of any hard cheese or processed cheese which complies with regulation 5(1) or 8(1), the label may bear instead of such description or declaration—

- (a) in the case of hard cheese, the name of the variety of such cheese, or
- (b) in the case of processed cheese, the word "processed" with the name of the variety of such processed cheese.

(4) No person shall sell by retail any compound product otherwise than in a container unless there appears on a ticket placed on or in immediate proximity to such compound product so as to be clearly visible to intending purchasers, as the description of such compound product, the appropriate description or declaration specified in regulation 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9 for the cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread present in such compound product together with a true description of any other food, except an ingredient permitted by regulation 12, present in such compound product:

Provided that in the case of hard cheese or processed cheese which complies with regulation 5(1) or 8(1), the ticket may bear instead of such description or declaration—

- (a) in the case of hard cheese, the name of the variety of such cheese, or
- (b) in the case of processed cheese, the word "processed" with the name of the variety of such processed cheese.

(5) Notwithstanding the provisions of regulations 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 and the preceding paragraphs, the description of any cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread may include, if penicillium moulds have produced blue-green veining in such cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread the word "blue-veined", or if such cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread contains sage, the word "sage".

14.—(1) Any advertisement for cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread shall include the description or declaration specified in regulation 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9 as the case may be:

Provided that in the case of hard cheese or processed cheese which complies with regulation 5(1) or 8(1), the advertisement may include instead of such description or declaration—

- (a) in the case of hard cheese, the name of the variety of such cheese, or
- (b) in the case of processed cheese, the word “processed” with the name of the variety of such processed cheese.

(2) Any cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread which is the subject of any description or declaration contained in any advertisement shall comply with the compositional requirements specified in regulation 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9 for cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread of such description.

(3) Any advertisement for any compound product shall include the description of such compound product specified in regulation 13(3) and (4) and the compound product so described shall comply with the compositional requirements specified in regulation 10.

(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of regulations 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 and paragraph (1), the description of any cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread may include, if penicillium moulds have produced blue-green veining in such cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread the word “blue-veined”, or if such cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread contains sage, the word “sage”.

(5) No person shall publish or be party to the publication of any advertisement which does not comply with this regulation.

*Requirements as to marking on labels on containers and on tickets*

15. All letters, words or numerals required by virtue of regulation 13 to appear on a label on a container or on a ticket respectively shall conform to the requirements for labels on containers and for tickets respectively set out in Schedule 2.

*Labelling and advertisement of cream cheese*

16. No person shall—

- (a) give with any cheese sold by him, or display with any cheese offered or exposed by him for sale any label, whether attached to or printed on the container or not, which bears any words or pictorial device, or
- (b) publish, or be party to the publication of, any advertisement for cheese which includes any words or pictorial device, or
- (c) use on, or in connection with, the sale of cheese any description, being words, a device or a description which are or is calculated to indicate either directly or by ambiguity, omission or inference that such cheese contains cream or is made from cream, unless such cheese complies with the compositional requirement for cream cheese which is specified in regulation 6(2).

PART IV

ADMINISTRATION AND GENERAL

*Penalties*

17.—(1) If any person contravenes or fails to comply with any of the foregoing provisions he shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction—



- (a) to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months, or to both such fine and such imprisonment; and
- (b) in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding five pounds for each day during which the offence continues after conviction.

(2) The requirements of Section 47(3) of the Act (which requires notice to be given to the Ministry of Health and Social Services of intention to begin a prosecution for an offence against any provisions relating to labelling, advertising or description of food) shall not apply as respects any proceedings instituted by a health authority for an offence against any such provisions.

#### Defences

18.—(1) In any proceedings for an offence in relation to the publication of an advertisement, it shall be a defence for the defendant to prove that, being a person whose business it is to publish or arrange for the publication of advertisements, he received the advertisement for publication in the ordinary course of business and did not himself make or cause to be made any material alteration in the substance of the advertisement.

(2) In any proceedings against the manufacturer or importer of cheese, processed cheese, cheese spread or of any compound product for an offence in relation to the publication of an advertisement, it shall rest on the defendant to prove that he did not publish and was not a party to the publication of the advertisement.

## SCHEDULE 2

## Regulation 15

**Requirements as to marking on labels on containers and on tickets**

1. Every letter, word or numeral appearing on a label on a container, or on a ticket, which is required so to appear by virtue of regulation 13 shall—

- (a) be clearly legible;
- (b) appear in a prominent position on the label or ticket;
- (c) be printed in a dark colour upon a light coloured ground or in a light colour upon a dark coloured ground;
- (d) be of uniform colour and size:

Provided that the initial letter in any such word may be larger than the other letters in that word.

2. Every letter in any word and every numeral in any description or declaration appearing on a label on a container which is required so to appear by virtue of regulation 13 shall be of such a size that if each letter (other than initial letters) and each numeral in such description or declaration were severally enclosed in the smallest rectangle capable of enclosing that letter or numeral, the area of the largest of such rectangles would be not less than nine-sixteenths of the area of the largest rectangle similarly enclosing any other letter (other than an initial letter) in any word of more than one letter appearing on any label on that container.

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**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

These regulations—

- (a) specify requirements for the composition and description of cheese including hard cheese, soft cheese (including cream cheese), whey cheese, processed cheese and cheese spread (regulations 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9);
- (b) apply compositional requirements for cheese, processed cheese or cheese spread sold as part of a compound product (regulation 10);
- (c) specify the permitted ingredients in cheese, processed cheese and cheese spread (regulation 12);
- (d) specify requirements for the labelling and advertisement of cheese, processed cheese, cheese spread and compound products (regulations 13, 14, 15 and 16);
- (e) include a consequential amendment of the Labelling of Food Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1961 so that cheese spread pre-packed for retail sale remains subject to provisions of those regulations (regulation 4).

The regulations do not apply, except insofar as they relate to advertisements, to cheese, processed cheese, cheese spread and compound products intended for export, for consumption by a visiting force, or for use for manufacturing purposes (regulation 3).
