WAGES COUNCILS**Wages Regulation (Road Haulage)**

ORDER, DATED 3RD JANUARY, 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER THE WAGES COUNCILS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1945.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 10 of the Wages Councils Act (Northern Ireland) 1945(a), hereby makes the following Order to give effect to wages regulation proposals received from the Road Haulage Wages Council (Northern Ireland):—

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Haulage Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1966.

Commencement

2. The wages regulation proposals set out in the Schedule shall come into operation on the specified date and on the day immediately preceding that date the Road Haulage Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1965(b) shall cease to have effect.

Interpretation

3. In this Order the expression “the specified date” means the 11th day of January, 1966, provided that where, as respects any worker who is paid wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, that date does not correspond with the beginning of the period for which the wages are paid, the expression “the specified date” means, as respects that worker, the beginning of the next such period following that date.

“CALCULATION OF HOURLY RATES

Paragraph 3.

The general minimum time rates specified in paragraph 1 and in sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph 2 are weekly rates based on a week of 41 hours.

For the purpose of calculating the hourly minimum rate the respective weekly rates should be divided by 41.”

3. for paragraph 4 there were substituted the following paragraph—

“NORMAL WORKING DAY

Paragraph 4.

The normal working week shall consist of—

4. for paragraph 5 there were substituted the following paragraph—

“OVERTIME

Paragraph 5.

All time worked in excess of the normal working day, as defined in paragraph 4, shall be regarded as overtime to which the overtime rates specified in paragraph 5A shall apply.”

5. the following new paragraph were inserted—

“OVERTIME RATES

Paragraph 5A.

The rates payable for overtime are:—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order, which comes into operation on 11th January, 1966, amends the Road Haulage Wages Regulation Order (Northern Ireland) 1961 (Order N.I.R.H. (26)), as amended by the Road Haulage Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1965 (Order N.I.R.H. (34)), by reducing the normal working week from one of 42 hours to one of 41 hours and making new provisions relating to overtime.

Order N.I.R.H. (34) is revoked.

New provisions in the Schedule are printed in italics.
