- 2. The notice required to be published under section 2(3) of the Registration of Clubs (Ireland) Act 1904 shall—
  - (a) where an application is made for a certificate of registration, be in the form set out in Part I of the Schedule;
  - (b) where an application is made for the renewal of a certificate of registration, be in the form set out in Part II of the Schedule.

## Headage Payments—Cattle

Scheme, dated 1st September 1966, made by the Minister of Agriculture under Section 1 of the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 as amended by the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland) 1957.

The Minister of Agriculture with the approval of the Minister of Finance and in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) Acts (Northern Ireland) 1954 and 1957(a) and of all other powers him thereunto enabling, hereby makes the following Scheme:—

Short title and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Scheme may be cited as the Cattle Headage Payments (Amendment) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1966.
- (2) This Scheme shall come into operation on the date hereof.

Amendment of the 1966 Scheme

2. After Article 2 of the Cattle Headage Payments Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1966(b) there shall be added the following Article:—
