INDUSTRIAL TRAINING

Clothing and Footwear Industry Training Board

ORDER, DATED 20TH SEPTEMBER 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER THE INDUSTRIAL TRAINING ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1964.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services after consultation with the Clothing and Footwear Industry Training Board and with organisations and associations of organisations appearing to it to be representative respectively of substantial numbers of employers engaging in the activities hereinafter mentioned and of substantial numbers of persons employed in those activities and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Industrial Training Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Industrial Training (Clothing and Footwear Board) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1966.

(2) In this Order—

“the Act” means the Industrial Training Act (Northern Ireland) 1964;

“the Board” means the Clothing and Footwear Industry Training Board;

“the principal Order” means the Industrial Training (Clothing and Footwear Board) Order (Northern Ireland) 1966(b).

Activities of the Board

2. The activities in relation to which the Board exercises the functions conferred by the Act upon industrial training boards shall be the activities specified in Schedule 1 to the principal Order as amended by the Schedule to this Order.

Paragraph 2	<p>For head (i) of sub-paragraph (d) there shall be substituted the following—</p> <p>"(i) the manufacture of lace, lace net, any knitted fabric or knitted article, other than the manufacture of a knitted article of wearing apparel or an article of wearing apparel embodying lace, lace net or embroidery or the manufacture of such lace, lace net, knitted fabric or knitted article for subsequent manufacture at the same establishment into an article specified in paragraph 1(b), (c), (d) or (e);"</p> <p>Head (ii) of sub-paragraph (d) shall be revoked.</p> <p>For head (iii) of sub-paragraph (d) there shall be substituted the following—</p> <p>"(iii) the manufacture of articles specified in paragraph (b), (c), (d) or (e) of paragraph 1 when carried out at or from an establishment excluded under head (i);"</p>

Paragraph 3	<p>Immediately after head (a) of sub-paragraph (1) there shall be inserted the following head—</p> <p>“(aa) “carrying out on commission” means the carrying out by a person in pursuance of a contract of work or labour (with or without the provision of materials) of a process or manufacture wholly or mainly upon or from materials owned in the course of his business by another person;”.</p> <p>Immediately after head (b) of sub-paragraph (1) there shall be inserted the following heads—</p> <p>“(ba) “knitted article” means any article manufactured on a knitting machine;</p> <p>(bb) “knitted fabric” means fabric manufactured on a knitting machine;</p> <p>(bc) “knitting machine” means a warp-knitting, weft-knitting or crocheting machine;</p> <p>(bd) “lace, lace net or embroidery” means any articles in the manufacture of which a process has been carried out on one or more of the following machines—</p> <p>Schiffli or other multi-needle shuttle embroidery machine, not being a single needle embroidery machine operated singly or in a battery;</p> <p>Barmen lace machine;</p> <p>Leavers lace machine;</p> <p>Nottingham lace curtain machine;</p> <p>Plain net machine;</p> <p>Raschel or other warp lace machine;”.</p> <p>Immediately after head (c) of sub-paragraph (1) there shall be inserted the following head—</p> <p>“(ca) “office premises” has the same meaning as in section 1(2) of the Office and Shop Premises Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(a).”.</p>

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Clothing and Footwear Industry Training Board was established on 15th June 1966 by the Industrial Training (Clothing and Footwear Board) Order (Northern Ireland) 1966 to exercise the functions of an industrial training board in relation to the activities of the clothing and footwear industry as specified in Schedule 1 to that Order.

This Order, which is made under section 10 of the Industrial Training Act (Northern Ireland) 1964, extends the activities in relation to which the Board exercises functions to include activities in connection with the manufacture of any knitted article of wearing apparel or of any article of wearing apparel embodying lace, lace net or embroidery.
