ROYAL ULSTER CONSTABULARY

Pay

ORDER, DATED 4TH OCTOBER 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE CONSTABULARY AND POLICE (IRELAND) ACT 1919 AND SECTION 2 OF THE CONSTABULARY ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1922.

I, the Right Honourable Robert William Brian McConnell, Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 4 of the Constabulary and Police (Ireland) Act 1919(a) and section 2 of the Constabulary Act (Northern Ireland) 1922(b) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, do hereby order as follows:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pay (Amending) Order 1966 and shall come into operation on 6th October 1966.

2. For Article 10 of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pay Order 1965(e) there shall be substituted the following Article:—

“10. There may be deducted from a member’s pay the amount of any sickness benefit under the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(d) or injury benefit under the National Insurance (Industrial Injuries) Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(e) to which the member was or may be entitled, together with any supplement thereto or payable therewith under section 2 of the National Insurance (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland) 1966”(f).

3. At the end of Article 6 of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pay Order 1966(g) shall be added the following words:—

“together with any supplement thereto or payable therewith under section 2 of the National Insurance (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland) 1966”.

Submission of Draft to Representative Body

I certify that section 4(2) of the Constabulary and Police (Ireland) Act 1919, which, as applied by the Constabulary Act (Northern Ireland) 1922, provides that a draft of any Order proposed to be made under the said section shall be submitted to the Representative Body or Bodies constituted by that Act and representing any rank or ranks affected, and that before the Order is made the Minister of Home Affairs shall consider any representations made by such Body or Bodies, has been fully observed.
