HOUSING ON FARMS

Grants in respect of farmhouses and of
approved workers' houses

ORDER*, DATED 10TH NOVEMBER 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF DEVELOPMENT, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER SECTION 12 OF THE HOUSING ON FARMS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1950.

*This Order was confirmed by Resolution of the Senate on the 24th day of January 1967 and of the House of Commons on the 18th day of January 1967.

The Ministry of Development (in this Order referred to as "the Ministry"), with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Ministry by section 12 of the Housing on Farms Act (Northern Ireland) 1950(a) (in this Order referred to as "the Act"), and of every other power it thereunto enabling, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Housing on Farms (Grants) Order (Northern Ireland) 1966, and shall, subject to the provisions of sub-section (4) of section 12 of the Act, come into operation on the 1st January 1967.

Grants for provision of new farmhouses

2. The amount of grant payable under section 1 of the Act in respect of a new farmhouse completed before the 1st January 1969, in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by the Ministry before the 1st January 1968, and falling within any one of the categories mentioned in the first column of the First Schedule shall be the amount specified opposite such category in the second column of the said Schedule.

Grants for provision of houses for approved workers

3. The amount of grant payable under section 4 of the Act in respect of an approved worker's house completed before the 1st January 1969, in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by the Ministry before the 1st January 1968, and falling within any one of the categories mentioned in the first column of the Second Schedule shall be the amount specified opposite such category in the second column of the said Schedule.

Grants for reconditioned premises as farmhouses or approved workers' houses

4. The amount of grant payable under section 7 of the Act in respect of the reconditioning of any premises for use as a farmhouse or approved worker's house completed before the 1st January 1969, in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by the Ministry on or after the 4th February 1955, and before the 1st January 1968, and falling within any one of the categories mentioned in the first column of the Third schedule shall be the amount specified opposite such category in the second column of the said Schedule.

NEW FARMHOUSES	
Where the superficial area of the new farmhouse exceeds 800 square feet and does not exceed 900 square feet	£330
Where the superficial area of the new farmhouse exceeds 900 square feet and does not exceed 1,500 square feet	£400

SECOND SCHEDULE

<i>Category of House</i>	<i>Amount of Grant payable by the Ministry</i>
NEW HOUSES FOR APPROVED WORKERS	
Where the superficial area of the new approved worker's house exceeds 650 square feet and does not exceed 850 square feet	£400
Where the superficial area of the new approved worker's house exceeds 850 square feet and does not exceed 1,050 square feet	£500

THIRD SCHEDULE

<i>Category of House</i>	<i>Amount of Grant payable by the Ministry</i>
Reconditioning of premises for occupation as farmhouses or approved workers' houses	(a) the sum of £400; or (b) a sum equal to the aggregate of two-thirds of that part of the approved cost of reconditioning which exceeds £75 and does not exceed £525 and one-half of that part, if any, which exceeds £525, whichever is the lesser.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The object of this Order is to extend to the 1st January 1968 the date before which plans for the provision of houses and the reconditioning of premises as houses on farms must be submitted to the Ministry of Development for approval in order to qualify for grant.

The Order also prescribes the rates of grant payable in respect of new farmhouses, approved workers' houses, and reconditioning works, and prescribes the dates before which work must be completed in order to qualify for the rates of grant specified.
