HEALTH SERVICES**Hospital Management Schemes**

ORDER, DATED 10TH FEBRUARY, 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER THE HEALTH SERVICES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1948.

Whereas by Order dated 12th April, 1949(a), the Ministry of Health and Local Government approved of management schemes relating to the hospitals named therein subject to certain modifications:

And whereas by Orders dated 30th April, 1949(b), 3rd June, 1953(c), 11th October, 1957(d), 26th November, 1958(e) and 18th December, 1959(f) the said Ministry approved new management schemes providing for the modification of the said management schemes:

And whereas the Northern Ireland Hospitals Authority after consultation with the Ministry of Health and Social Services (in this Order referred to as "the Ministry"), on the 1st day of February, 1966, adopted a new management scheme providing for the further modification of the said management schemes:

And whereas the Ministry thinks fit to approve of the said new management scheme:

Now, therefore, the Ministry, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland) 1948(g) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Health Services (Approval of Hospital Management Schemes) Order (Northern Ireland) 1966.

2. The Ministry hereby approves of the management scheme dated the 1st day of February, 1966, and directs that a copy of the management scheme as amended and approved by the Ministry relating to each hospital included in the Schedule hereto shall be available at that hospital for inspection by members of the public at all reasonable times.
