HEALTH SERVICES

General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services-Appliances and Reagents

REGULATIONS, DATED 10TH MARCH, 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER THE HEALTH SERVICES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1948.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 12 of the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland) 1948(a) and in conjunction with the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Services (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) (Appliances and Reagents) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966.

2. The Health Services (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1956(b) shall be amended as follows:—

- (1) In Part I of Schedule 2:
 - (a) the items "Bandages: muslin", "Inhalers: Burney Yeo", "Pessaries: inflatable ball: for replacements only" and "Pinchcocks" shall be deleted;
 - (b) for the words "Vaccination shields and pads" there shall be substituted the words "Vaccination pads";
 - (c) after the item "Lints: unmedicated" there shall be added the item "Metatarsal pads".

(2) For Part II of Schedule 2 there shall be substituted the following part:
