COUNTY COURT APPEALS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1964**Date of Commencement**

ORDER, DATED 6TH JANUARY, 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 10(3) OF THE COUNTY COURT APPEALS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1964(a).

I, the Right Honourable Robert William Brian McConnell, Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 10(3) of the County Court Appeals Act (Northern Ireland) 1964 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") do hereby order as follows:—

Appointed day for the operation of the Act

1. The Act shall come into operation on the 1st day of February, 1966.

2. This Order may be cited as the County Court Appeals Act (Northern Ireland) 1964 Date of Commencement Order 1966.

WAGES COUNCILS

Wages Regulation (Retail Bespoke Tailoring)

ORDER, DATED 10TH JANUARY, 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER THE WAGES COUNCILS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1945.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 10 of the Wages Councils Act (Northern Ireland) 1945(a), hereby makes the following Order to give effect to wages regulation proposals received from the Retail Bespoke Tailoring Wages Council (Northern Ireland):—

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Retail Bespoke Tailoring Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1966.

Commencement

2. The wages regulation proposals set out in the Schedule shall come into operation on the specified date.

Interpretation

3. In this Order the expression "the specified date" means the 18th day of January, 1966, provided that where, as respects any worker who is paid wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, that date does not correspond with the beginning of the period for which the wages are paid, the expression "the specified date" means, as respects that worker, the beginning of the next such period following that date.
