# Wages Regulation (Retail Bespoke Tailoring)

ORDER, DATED 10TH JANUARY, 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER THE WAGES COUNCILS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1945.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 10 of the Wages Councils Act (Northern Ireland) 1945(a), hereby makes the following Order to give effect to wages regulation proposals received from the Retail Bespoke Tailoring Wages Council (Northern Ireland):—

#### Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Retail Bespoke Tailoring Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1966.

#### Commencement

2. The wages regulation proposals set out in the Schedule shall come into operation on the specified date.

#### Interpretation

3. In this Order the expression "the specified date" means the 18th day of January, 1966, provided that where, as respects any worker who is paid wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, that date does not correspond with the beginning of the period for which the wages are paid, the expression "the specified date" means, as respects that worker, the beginning of the next such period following that date.

# Redundancy Payments-Rebates

REGULATIONS, DATED 10TH JANUARY, 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER SECTION 40(4) OF THE CONTRACTS OF EMPLOYMENT AND REDUNDANCY PAYMENTS—ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1965.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services in exercise of powers conferred by section 40(4) of the Contracts of Employment and Redundancy Payments Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Regulations:—

# Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Contracts of Employment and Redundancy Payments (Rebates) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966 and shall come into operation on the 31st January, 1966.

#### A mendment

- 2. The Contracts of Employment and Redundancy Payments (Rebates) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1965(b) shall be amended as follows:—
- (1) In Regulation 3(2)(a) for the words "twenty-eight days" there shall be substituted the words "twenty-one days".
- (2) In Regulation 3 there shall be added the following paragraph:—
  - "(3) In calculating whether an employee is one of ten or more employees in whose case Regulation 3(2)(a) applies no account shall be taken of any employee who is one of ten or more employees as aforesaid as respects whom prior notice as required by this Regulation has already been given."
