PENSION**Increase of Pensions**

ORDER, DATED 25TH MARCH, 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION 7(1) OF THE PENSIONS (INCREASE) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1966.

The Ministry of Finance in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 7(1) of the Pensions (Increase) Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Increase of Pensions (Appointed Day) Order (Northern Ireland) 1966.

2. For the purposes of the Pensions (Increase) Act (Northern Ireland) 1966, the appointed day shall be the 1st day of January, 1966.

BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES (FEES)

ORDER IN COUNCIL*, DATED 25TH MARCH, 1966, MADE UNDER THE REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES (FEES, ETC.) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1955.

BY THE GOVERNOR IN THE PRIVY COUNCIL OF NORTHERN IRELAND

ERSKINE OF RERRICK

Whereas by section 1 of the Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages (Fees, etc.) Act (Northern Ireland) 1955(b) it is, amongst other things, provided that an Order in Council prescribing the fees payable for or in respect of the solemnisation of marriages and certain matters regulated by the enactments relating to the registration of births, deaths, marriages and adoptions may be made by the Governor after a draft thereof has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

And whereas it is expedient that certain fees as in the Schedule set forth should be so prescribed in respect of the events and transactions therein respectively set forth:

And whereas a draft of this Order has duly been laid before and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, I, John Maxwell, Baron Erskine of Rerrick, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor of Northern Ireland, by and with the consent of the Privy Council of Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred by the said section and of all other powers me thereunto enabling do hereby order as follows:—

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Births, Deaths and Marriages (Fees) Order (Northern Ireland) 1966.

(2) This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1966.

Fees payable

2. The amounts of the fees payable under the several enactments set forth in the first column of the Schedule in respect of the events and transactions described in the second column thereof shall be those specified respectively in the third column thereof.

Revocation of Order

3. The Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages (Fees) Order (Northern Ireland) 1956(a) is hereby revoked.

EDUCATION

Superannuation

The Ministry of Education, in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Section 3 of the Teachers (Superannuation) (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland) 1956(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Teachers (Superannuation) (Supplementary Contributions) Order (Northern Ireland) 1966.

(2) This Order shall take effect from the first day of April, nineteen hundred and sixty-six.

2.—(1) Supplementary contributions at the rate of 3 per cent. per annum shall be payable by employers in respect of all teachers employed by them to whom Part I of the Teachers (Superannuation) Act (Northern Ireland) 1950(b), (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1950”) from time to time applies.

(2) Supplementary contributions under this Order shall be payable in addition to, at the same time and in the same manner as the contributions payable by employers under section 6 of the Act of 1950.
