FOYLE FISHERIES

Foyle Area (River Foyle Angling Authorisation) Regulations 1966

REGULATIONS, DATED 16TH MARCH, 1966, MADE BY THE FOYLE FISHERIES COMMISSION WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER FOR AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES IN THE IRISH REPUBLIC UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE FOYLE FISHERIES ACT, 1952, AND OF THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE FOYLE FISHERIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1952.

The Foyle Fisheries Commission hereinafter referred to as "the Commission" in exercise of its power under Section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act, 1952, and Section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1952, hereby makes the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Foyle Area (River Foyle Angling Authorisation) Regulations, 1966, and shall come into force on the first day of April, 1966.

2. A person shall not fish for salmon with rod and line on any part of the River Foyle unless he is a holder of:—

- a valid season salmon rod licence issued or endorsed by the Commission in pursuance of the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) Regulations, 1960, and the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) (Amendment) Regulations, 1965, and
- (2) a valid River Foyle Angling Authorisation issued by the Commission in pursuance of these regulations.

3.--(1) Applications for a River Foyle Angling Authorisation shall be made in the form specified in the Schedule of these regulations and shall be sent to the office of the Commission.

(2) An application submitted in accordance with the last preceding paragraph may be refused by the Commission.

(3) Every application approved by the Commission shall be endorsed by an officer authorised by the Commission in that behalf and be returned to the applicant.

(4) On lodgment of such duly approved application with any Licence Distributor, together with a fee of $\pounds 1$ 0s. 0d., the authorisation shall be issued to the applicant.

(5) No application for a River Foyle Angling Authorisation shall be approved by the Commission, unless the applicant is the holder of a valid season rod licence issued or endorsed by the Commission. Foyle Fisheries
