**The Factories (Fire Certificate Application) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1967**

ORDER, DATED 13TH JUNE 1967, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER THE FACTORIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1965.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland in exercise of powers conferred by Section 41(2) of the Factories Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(a) and of all other powers in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Factories (Fire Certificate Application) Order (Northern Ireland) 1967 and shall come into operation on the 23rd day of June 1967.

(2) The Factories (Fire Certificate Application) Order (Northern Ireland) 1962(b) is hereby revoked.

2. An application to the fire authority for a certificate under Section 41 of the Factories Act (Northern Ireland) 1965 (that is to say, a certificate that premises are provided with such means of escape in case of fire for the persons employed in the factory as may reasonably be required in the circumstances of the case)—

- (a) except in any case to which paragraph (b) applies, shall be in the form set out in Part I of the Schedule; and
- (b) in any case in which the owner of a building is making such an application in the case of a factory to which Section 118 of and Schedule 2 to the Act (which relate to factories occupying parts of buildings) apply, shall be in the form set out in Part II of the Schedule.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order prescribes the form of applications for certificates under Section 41 of the Factories Act (Northern Ireland) 1965 that premises are provided with such means of escape in case of fire as may reasonably be required in the circumstances of the case. The form is in two parts—

- (a) for occupiers of factories; and
- (b) for owners of buildings, in relation to factories occupying parts of those buildings.

The form prescribed by this Order is in substitution for that prescribed by the Factories (Fire Certificate Application) Order (Northern Ireland) 1962 which is revoked.

The Docks Certificates Order (Northern Ireland) 1967

ORDER, DATED 13TH JUNE 1967, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER THE DOCKS REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1934.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland in pursuance of Regulation 22(a) of the Docks Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1934(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Regulations") hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Docks Certificates Order (Northern Ireland) 1967, and shall come into operation on the 23rd day of June 1967.

Pulley blocks

2. The certificate of any test and examination of a pulley block made in pursuance of Regulation 19(a) of the Regulations shall be in the form set out in Part I of the Schedule and shall contain the particulars therein specified.

Chains, rings, hooks, shackles or swivels

3. The certificate of any test and examination of a chain, ring, hook, shackle or swivel made in pursuance of Regulation 19(a) of the Regulations shall be in the form set out in Part II of the Schedule and shall contain the particulars therein specified.
