LOCAL GOVERNMENT**Qualifications of Senior Assistant Engineers**

REGULATIONS, DATED 26TH SEPTEMBER 1967, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF DEVELOPMENT UNDER SECTION 18 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1934.

The Ministry of Development (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry"), in exercise of the powers vested in it by section 18 of the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1934(a), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Local Authorities (Senior Assistant Engineers Qualifications) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1967.

2. A person shall not be qualified to be appointed as a senior assistant engineer, or to an engineering office which is, in the opinion of the Ministry, of comparable status (by whatever name called), of the council of a county or a county or other borough or urban or rural district, or joint board partly appointed by such council, unless—

- (a) he is a corporate member of the Institution of Civil Engineers, or of the Institution of Municipal Engineers; and
- (b) since becoming such corporate member, he has had adequate and suitable experience and has shown capacity in the practice of his profession.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations prescribe qualifications for Senior Assistant Engineers and for engineers of comparable status employed by local authorities.
