These regulations provide for returns from dealers in salmon and trout and from commercial catchers of salmon and trout to be made to the Ministry of Agriculture.

Selective Employment Payments

REGULATIONS, DATED 20TH OCTOBER 1967, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER SECTION 52 OF THE CONTRACTS OF EMPLOYMENT AND REDUNDANCY PAYMENTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1965.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services in exercise of powers conferred by section 52 of the Contracts of Employment and Redundancy Payments Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation, interpretation and commencement

1. These Regulations, which may be cited as the Industrial Tribunals (Selective Employment Payments) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1967, shall be read as one with the Industrial Tribunals (Selective Employment Payments) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966(b) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") and shall come into operation on 23rd October 1967.

Amendment of principal Regulations

2. For paragraph (2) of Regulation 3 (procedure of tribunals) of the principal Regulations there shall be substituted the following paragraph:

"(2) This Regulation applies to proceedings for the determination of any question which an employer may require to be referred to and determined by a tribunal under-

- (a) the Selective Employment Payments Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(c); or
- (b) any enactment for the time being in force which is to be construed as one with that Act."

Amendment of rules of procedure

3. The following amendments shall be made to the Rules of Procedure contained in the Schedule to the principal Regulations, namely:

- (a) in Rule 1 (originating application) for the words "Forms 1 to 5" there shall be substituted the words "the forms of originating application in

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the Appendix": and

(b) in paragraph (4) of Rule 7 (procedure at hearing) for the words "the chairman may administer" there shall be substituted the words "there may be administered".

Additional forms of originating application

4. The two forms of originating application set out in the Schedule and numbered respectively 5A and 5B shall be inserted after Form 5 in the Appendix to the Rules of Procedure scheduled to the principal Regulations.

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations amend the Industrial Tribunals (Selective Employment Payments) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966 so as to bring within their scope the determination of questions arising on claims under section 14 of and Schedule 1 to the Finance Act (Northern Ireland) 1967 for refunds of selective employment tax in respect of part-time workers or persons employed cutside the United Kingdom.
