SUPERANNUATION

Order in Council, dated 6th March 1967, made under section 5(1)(e) of the Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland) 1951.

BY THE GOVERNOR IN THE PRIVY COUNCIL OF NORTHERN IRELAND

ERSKINE OF RERRICK

Whereas by section 5(1)(e) of the Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland) 1951(a), the Governor of Northern Ireland is empowered to designate by Order in Council a class of employment as pensionable employment for the purposes of that section where the Ministry of Finance is satisfied that the employment entitles a person therein employed to superannuation benefits substantially similar to those conferred by or under the Superannuation Acts:

And whereas the Ministry of Finance is satisfied that the employments mentioned in the Schedule entitle a person therein employed to superannuation benefits substantially similar to those conferred by or under the Superannuation Acts:

Now, therefore, I, John Maxwell, Baron Erskine of Rerrick, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor of Northern Ireland, by and with the advice of the Privy Council of Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me as aforesaid do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. The employments mentioned in the Schedule are hereby designated pensionable employments for the purposes of section 5(1)(e) of the Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland) 1951.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the Superannuation (Designated Employment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1967, and shall come into operation on the 15th day of March 1967.

SCHEDULE

- 1. Employment under the National Coal Board or the Coal Industry Social Welfare Organisation which is pensionable under the National Coal Board Staff Superannuation Scheme.
- 2. Employment under the United Kingdom Atomic Energy Authority or the Science Research Council which is pensionable under the United Kingdom Atomic Energy Authority's Principal Non-Industrial Superannuation Scheme, Industrial Superannuation Scheme or Protected Persons Superannuation Scheme.
- 3. Employment under the Electricity Council, the Central Electricity Generating Board or any of the Area Electricity Boards which is pensionable under the Electricity Supply (Staff) Superannuation Scheme or the Electricity Supply (Manual Workers) Superannuation Scheme.
- 4. Employment as general staff under the British Overseas Airways Corporation or the British European Airways Corporation which is pensionable under the Airways Corporations Joint Pension Scheme.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Sections 5(1) and 6(1) of the Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland) 1951 make provision for the making of rules to preserve continuity of pension rights where pensionable staff transfer between the Civil Service and certain other employments. This Order designates employments under a number of Public Boards as employments for the purposes of those subsections.

ROAD TRAFFIC

Speed Limits

Order, dated 10th March 1967, made by the Ministry of Home Affairs under section 23(4) of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1955.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 23(4) of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1955(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders and directs as follows:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Roads (Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1967 and shall come into operation on 20th March 1967.
