REGULATIONS, DATED 13TH APRIL 1967, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION 15(1) OF THE EXCHEQUER AND FINANCIAL PROVISIONS ACT (Northern Ireland) 1950.

The Ministry of Finance in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 15(1) of the Exchequer and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1950(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Ulster Savings Certificates (Eleventh Issue) (Amendment) Regulations 1967.
- (2) These Regulations shall be construed as one with the Ulster Savings Certificates Regulations 1962 to 1967(b) and those Regulations and these Regulations may be cited together as the Ulster Savings Certificates Regulations 1962 to 1967.
- 2. In paragraph (g) of Schedule 3 to the Ulster Savings Certificates Regulations 1962 as amended(c), (which Schedule prescribes the maximum number of certificates which may be held), for the words "Five hundred" there shall be substituted the words "Seven hundred and fifty".
- 3. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 14th day of April 1967.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of these Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations amend the Ulster Savings Certificates (Eleventh Issue) Regulations 1966. Their effect is to increase the maximum permitted holding of Ulster Savings Certificates of the Eleventh Issue from 500 unit Certificates (£500) to 750 unit Certificates (£750) as from 14th April 1967.
