REGULATIONS, DATED 1ST MAY 1968, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER THE NATIONAL INSURANCE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1966.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services, in conjunction with the Ministry of Finance, in exercise of powers conferred by paragraph 18 of Schedule 9 to the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations, which may be cited as the National Insurance (New Entrants Transitional) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1968, shall be read as one with the National Insurance (New Entrants Transitional) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1948(b) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") and shall come into operation on 6th May 1968.

Amendment of the principal regulations

2. Schedule 2(c) to the principal regulations (amounts payable, by way of refund of contributions, to persons entering insurance too late to be able to satisfy the contribution conditions for widow's benefit or retirement pension) shall be amended by the addition, immediately after paragraph 6 thereof, of the provisions contained in the Schedule to these regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations are made in consequence of the passing of section 1(1) of the Public Expenditure and Receipts Act (Northern Ireland) 1968 which provides for higher flat-rate contributions payable under the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland) 1966.

The regulations prescribe the appropriate amounts to be refunded to persons who enter insurance too late to be able to satisfy the contribution conditions for widow's benefit or retirement pension in respect of contributions payable for weeks commencing on or after 6th May 1968.
