Secondary Schools (Grant Conditions)

REGULATIONS, DATED 26TH JUNE 1968, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1947 TO 1968, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 84 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland) 1947(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Secondary Schools (Grant Conditions) Amending Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1968, and shall come into operation on 1st August 1968.

2. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Secondary Schools (Grant Conditions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1965(b).

3. For the proviso to paragraph (1) of Regulation 11 of the existing Regulations there shall be substituted the following:—

"Provided that the requirement as to the number of hours of class instruction may be modified to such extent and in such circumstances as may be approved by the Ministry".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but it is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations provide for relaxation of the requirement that a teacher appointed in a full-time capacity must devote not less than 20 hours per week to class instruction in subjects of the approved time-table.
