Secondary Schools (Grant Conditions)

REGULATIONS, DATED 29TH JULY 1968, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1947 TO 1968 WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Section 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland) 1947(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Secondary Schools (Grant Conditions) Amending Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1968 No. 2.
- 2. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Secondary Schools (Grant Conditions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1965(b).
- 3. For paragraph (1) of Regulation 6 of the existing Regulations there shall be substituted the following paragraph:—

"The instruction to be given in a school shall be determined by the school authorities with due regard to the ages, abilities and aptitudes of the pupils, and the curriculum, syllabus and time-table shall be subject to the approval of the Ministry."
