Teachers' Salaries and Allowances

REGULATIONS, DATED 23RD SEPTEMBER 1968, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1947 TO 1968.

The Ministry of Education, in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 83 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland) 1947(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Teachers' Salaries Amending Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1968, No. 2.

2. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1967(b).

3. For paragraph (2) of Regulation 14 of the existing Regulations there shall be substituted the following:—

“(2) (a) A points score shall be determined for each special school in respect of each school year on the basis of the number of pupils enrolled in the school on the second Friday following the opening of the school for the second term in the preceding school year, the number of pupils thus ascertained being classified according to the following:—

	<i>Each pupil</i>
Delicate or educationally sub-normal pupils	4 points
Blind, partially sighted, epileptic or physically handicapped pupils	5 points
Deaf, partially hearing, maladjusted or pupils suffering from speech defect	6 points

provided that where a pupil has multiple handicaps, the handicap from which he is suffering which attracts the highest points value shall count for this purpose.

(b) For the purpose of determining the principal's scale or the amount of the vice-principal's allowance in a special school for the triennial period 1st August 1967 to 31st July 1970, the points average shall be deemed to be the same as the points score of the school for the school year 1967/68 as determined in accordance with the provisions of sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph.

(c) For the purpose of determining the number of posts for which graded allowances may be paid in a special school for the school years 1968/69 and 1969/70 the points average shall be deemed to be the same as the points score of the school for the school year 1967/68 as determined in accordance with the provisions of sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph.”

4. The provisions of Regulation 13 of the existing Regulations shall continue to apply except in so far as they are amended in respect of special schools by sub-paragraphs (b) and (c) of Regulation 3 of these Regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations provide with effect from 1st August 1967 for a modification of the calculation of the points scores for special schools.

Partridge and Hen Pheasants

This Order, prohibiting the killing and sale or purchase of hen pheasants for consumption (with certain exceptions) and prohibiting the sale or purchase of partridge for consumption during the period 1st October 1968 to 30th September 1969, being of temporary effect, is not printed at length in this volume.
