ROAD TRAFFIC

Speed Limits

ORDER, DATED 22ND NOVEMBER 1968, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 23(4) OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1955.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 23(4) of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1955(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders and directs as follows:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Roads (Speed Limit) (No. 6) Order (Northern Ireland) 1968 and shall come into operation on 27th November 1968.

Restriction of Road

2. The length of road specified in the Schedule shall be a restricted road for the purposes of section 23 of the Act.

SCHEDULE

The Armagh-Markethill Road, Class I, No. A.28, Co. Armagh, from the Armagh Urban District Boundary to a point approximately 7,040 yards in a southeasterly direction.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order has the effect of applying the 30 m.p.h. speed limit to a section of the Armagh-Markethill Road, which is being reconstructed. It is intended to remove the restriction when works are complete.
