Housing Subsidy Order

Order*, dated 13th December 1968, made by the Ministry of Development, with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, under Section 1 of the Housing (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland) 1946.

The Ministry of Development (in this Order referred to as "the Ministry") with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Ministry by section 1 of the Housing (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland) 1946(a), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Housing Subsidy (Variation) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1968 and shall be construed as one with the Housing Subsidy Order (Northern Ireland) 1962(b).

2. In its application to a housing scheme in respect of which the tender has been submitted for approval to the Ministry after 15th December 1968, the Housing Subsidy Order (Northern Ireland) 1962 shall be amended by substituting for the Schedule contained therein the Schedule to this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Under this Order subsidies to local authorities, the Northern Ireland Housing Trust and housing associations are revised (upwards) in respect of houses for which tenders are submitted to the Ministry for approval, or accepted by the Trust or housing associations, after 15th December 1968.
