POULTRY**Poultry Test**

ORDER, DATED 22ND JANUARY 1968, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 9 OF THE AGRICULTURE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1949(a).

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 9 of the Agriculture Act (Northern Ireland) 1949 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and Commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Poultry Testing (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1968 and shall be construed as one with the Poultry Testing Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1967(b) (in this Order referred to as the "Principal Order").

(2) This Order shall come into operation on the 19th day of February 1968.

Amendment of the Principal Order

2. For Paragraph (1) of Article 8 of the Poultry Testing Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1967 there shall be substituted:—

"(1) The fee, which shall be paid when application for entry is made, shall be £150 per entry for birds submitted by poultry breeders operating in Northern Ireland and £350 per entry for birds submitted by poultry breeders operating outside Northern Ireland."
