Housing Subsidy Order

ORDER*, DATED 5TH APRIL 1968, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF DEVELOPMENT, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER SECTION 1 OF THE HOUSING (NO. 2) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1946.

The Ministry of Development (in this Order referred to as "the Ministry"), with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Ministry by Section 1 of the Housing (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland) 1946(a), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Housing Subsidy (Hostels and Flatlets) Order (Northern Ireland) 1968 and shall be construed as one with the Housing Subsidy Order (Northern Ireland) 1956(b) (in this Order referred to as "the principal Order").

2. In Article 5 of the principal Order for the sums of "thirty-three pounds" and "eleven pounds" there shall be substituted respectively the sums of "forty-eight pounds" and "sixteen pounds".

3. In paragraph (2) of Article 8A of the principal Order for the sums of "fifty-four pounds" and "eighteen pounds" there shall be substituted respectively the sums of "seventy-five pounds" and "twenty-five pounds".

4. In paragraph (3) of Article 8A of the principal Order for the sums of "forty-two pounds" and "fourteen pounds" there shall be substituted respectively the sums of "sixty pounds" and "twenty pounds".

5. This Order shall apply to a housing scheme in respect of which the tender has been submitted for approval to the Ministry after the date of this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order increases the rates of subsidies payable to local authorities, the Northern Ireland Housing Trust and housing associations in respect of the provision of certain types of housing accommodation for old people and single workers.
